

What do your wedding packages include?

My packages are very simple. They include my photography services for the amount of time you choose, an edited high-resolution flash drive of images with printing rights, and an online ordering gallery for your friends and family. My packages also include timeline development and venue coordination.

How many photos will I receive on my flash drive?

I never limit the amount of photos I take. During posed portraits I take a TON of the exact same pose to ensure I get the perfect shot. I then provide a few photos per pose omitting camera tests, blinks, and duplicates. Unposed candid moments cannot be replicated, so even if a photo isn't perfect, it will still be included in your final gallery. Every wedding and couple is different but I typically deliver somewhere between 500-800 photos.

Do you have an online gallery for my friends and family?

Yes! Once I'm done editing your photos, you will receive a link to your online gallery. Your friends and family can view, share, and download any photos they like at no cost. They can also order prints.

When do you need the deposit and final payment?

I need the deposit as soon as possible to secure your date. I cannot guarantee your date will be saved until I receive the deposit. The rest of the balance owed is due 30 days before the wedding. For your convenience, you are welcome to pay your final balance in advance or make multiple payments. I accept cash, check or credit cards for any payments.

Is there a travel fee?

I require a very reasonable travel fee for weddings more than 30 miles away from my location. Contact me for more information.

When should I give you my itinerary?

About 4 weeks before your event, I will send you a questionnaire via email. This will help me establish a photography schedule and answer any questions I might have. I'm always available to answer any questions you have along the way regarding the timing of things. I'm happy to make suggestions and give advice.

How do you back up your photos?

While photographing your wedding I shoot to 2 memory cards simultaneously. If one card fails, I have duplicate photos on the other memory card. Your photos will remain on those memory cards until they have been edited and delivered to you. After your event I upload your photos to my desktop computer, multiple external hard drives, and an offsite location. Your photos remain in these locations until delivery confirmation.

When will we get our flash drive?

My turnaround time is typically between 2 and 4 weeks, depending on quantity of photos and current work volume.

When will you arrive on my wedding day?

Every wedding is different! Contact me at any time to discuss your unique day and timeline.

Who gets pictures taken and when?

Pictures will include the bride and groom, bridal party, and immediate family. I also try to capture candid photos of you and your guests throughout the day. The photos are not limited to these and I can accommodate any specific requests you have throughout the time that I am there. Don't stress out about who is having their pictures taken and where - that's what I'm there for. I can help you decide the flow of the photography once I get an itinerary. You are welcome to leave it all up to me.

Can I give you a list of all the photos I want?

I have a long list of photos that I like to capture at every wedding. If you have photos that are unique to your specific needs, please feel free to send me a list or photo examples. I will make every reasonable effort to take the photos specifically requested.

What if I feel I need your services for more time on the big day?

No problem. I rarely book more than one wedding a day, so if you think you need more coverage than you originally anticipated; we can add more time to your package. We can simply adjust your package choice or you can add an extra hour to any package at any time.

What happens if you get sick the day of my wedding?

Unless I am deathly ill or something tragic happens, I will be there, regardless. In the event something tragic does happen, I have several assistants and trusted partners in the profession I can count on to take my place.

What camera equipment do you have?

I carry 3 professional Nikon cameras as well as several lenses, and a variety of lighting equipment.

Are you insured?

Yep!
